Original – "to give a defense or reason for something." Current – "an unjustified or false reason for something, a false reason given to cover up the real reason."

- "Company kept me away."
- "The worship is not interesting."
- "I'm not getting anything out of it."
- "The weather was bad ..."
- "There's too many hypocrites."

FLIMSY EXCUSES

"Lord, I will serve you IF:
I feel well, not too busy with other things, the rest of my family does, I don't have any little ones, company doesn't come, the worship is interesting, I really enjoy it, the weather is good, all others are serving You." Does Anyone Really Think God Will Accept These Excuses?

EXCUSES SAY WE DON'T CARE TO SERVE THE LORD AND HE IS UNWORTHY OF REVERENCE AND RESPECT
