

OBEY GOD

Jerimiah 11:7,8 :7 For I earnestly protested unto your fathers in the day that I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, even unto this day, rising early and protesting, saying, Obey my voice.

:8 Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not. KJV

Jerimiah 18:8-12 :8 If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil , I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them.

:9 And at what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it;

:10 If it do evil in my sight, that it obey not my voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them.

Malachi 1:6-8 :6,7 :8 And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil ? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil ? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts. KJV

TEACH THEM

Exodus 18:19-23 :19 Hearken now unto my voice, I will give thee counsel, and God shall be with thee: Be thou for the people to Godward, that thou mayest bring the causes unto God:

:20 And thou shalt teach them ordinances and laws, and shalt shew them the way wherein they must walk, and the work that they must do. KJV Deuteronomy 6:7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. KJV

11:19 And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. KJV

TO TEACH

Matthew 5:19-20 :19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them , the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. KJV

Mark 6:34 And Jesus, when he came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things.

SEEK Ye First

Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. KJV

7:2-8 :7 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: :8 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that

seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. KJV

Matthew 16:18,19 :18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. KJV

THE SUPPER

Luke 22:16-20 :16 For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God.

:17 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves:

:18 For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come.

:19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me.

:20 Likewise also the cup after supper , saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.

THE PROMISE TO THE APOSTLES

Luke 24:44-49 :44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.

:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

:46-49 And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

THE PROMISE COMPLETED

Acts 2:46,47 :46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,

:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. KJV

Paul Speaks Clearly of Church Pattern

Paul greets the Philippian Church, addressing <u>all the members</u>, the <u>bishops</u> and <u>deacons</u>.

Phil 1:1-6:1 Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all <u>the saints</u> in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with <u>the bishops</u> and <u>deacons</u>: KJV





Four ways by which Authority may be established:

- •Direct Statement or Command (Precept)
- Approved Example (Example approved by an inspired man)
- •Necessary Inference (A conclusion that is forced)
- •The silence of the Scriptures

LIVELY STONES

1 Peter 2:1-5 :4 To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious,

:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:6,7 :6 Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded.

:7 Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, 1 Peter 2:8,9 :8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

LIVE FAITHFULLY

1 Cor 4:1,2 :1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.

:2 Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful . KJV
