Dangers For Every Generation

(Part 2)

- Joshua 24:15, "And if it seem evil unto you to serve Jehovah, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve Jehovah."
- We all make choices. (Romans 6:16-18)

The Loss Of The Godly Home

- Man is to provide leadership for his wife and love her <u>as Christ also loved</u> <u>the church</u>.
 Ephesians 5:22-33; Leave and cleave. Genesis 2:24
- Dwell with her. 1 Peter 3:7

The Loss Of The Godly Home

- > The woman's role is a role of quiet subjection.
 - >1 Peter 3:1; Ephesians 5:22-24, 33.
 - Place of importance. Proverbs 18:22
 "Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favor of the Lord."

The Loss Of The Godly Home

Effect upon children.

- > Moral values decline.
 - >Even in the church. 1 Corinthians 5:6
 - >No ability to blush. Jeremiah 6:15
 - >Believe we have freedom without consequence.
 - Jeremiah 23:17; cf. Galatians 6:7-8

The Loss Of Hunger For Righteousness

- "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied." (Matthew 5:6) cf. Hebrews 5:11ff
 - Jeremiah 6:10, "To whom shall I speak and testify, that they may hear? behold, their ear is uncircumcised, and they cannot hearken: behold, the word of Jehovah is become unto them a reproach; they have no delight in it."

The Loss Of Hunger For Righteousness

- <u>What will the next generation be</u>? Judges 2:10
- Amos 8:11, "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord Jehovah, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of Jehovah."

The Loss Of Hunger For Righteousness

- Motivated to greater evangelism
 - If people are viewed as lost and without hope ... Ephesians 2
- Jesus talked with the Samaritan woman. John4
 - Jesus created a craving for what He offered. John 4:13-14
 - Jesus taught her how to worship. John 4:21-24
 - Jesus taught her He was the Messiah. John 4:25-26

The Loss Of The Sacred

Sacred - "Holy" (KJV) vs. Profane

- 2 Timothy 3:15, "And that from a babe thou hast known the <u>sacred</u> writings..."
- Acts 24:6, "… who moreover assayed to <u>profane</u> the temple"

The Loss Of The Sacred

Illustrations of the Sacred.

- > Sabbath day. (Exodus 20:8; cf. Numbers 15:32-36)
- Moses drew near the burning bush in the wilderness, God said, "Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground" (Exodus 3:5)
- Nadab and Abihu. "I will be sanctified in them that come nigh me, and before all the people I will be glorified" (Leviticus 10:3).

The Loss Of The Sacred

Illustrations of the Sacred.

- John "fell at his feet as though dead" (Revelation 1:17)
- Jews in Nehemiah's day, when the law was read. (Nehemiah 9:3)
- Worship. "Let us have grace, whereby we may offer service well-pleasing to God with reverence and awe: for our God is a consuming fire" (Hebrews 12:28-29).
- NOTE: To treat what is holy (sacred) as if it were common profanes it.

The Loss Of Distinctiveness

Distinctions in Scripture. 1 Peter 2:5-10

- Wide way from the narrow way. (Matthew 7:13-14)
- ▶ Wise from the foolish. (Matthew 7:24-27)
- Kingdom of darkness from the Kingdom of Christ. (Colossians 1:13-14)

The Loss Of Distinctiveness

Distinctions In Scripture.

- Those who belong to the evil one from those who are born of God. (1 John 5:18-19)
- > One way from all others. (John 14:6)
- > The gospel from all others. (Galatians 1:6-9)
- One body (church) from all others. (Ephesians 1:22-23; 4:4)
- > One baptism from all others. (Ephesians 4:5)

The Loss Of Distinctiveness

- We cannot blend God's way with man's way. (Proverbs 14:12)
- Cain and Abel. Genesis 4
- Nadab and Abihu. Leviticus 10
- King Saul. 1 Samuel 15
- Uzzah. 2 Samuel 6; cf. 1 Chronicles 15
- King Uzziah. 2 Chronicles 26
- A Separate People. Deuteronomy 7:6; 1 Peter
 2:9; 2 Corinthians 6:17ff; Romans 12:1-2

The Loss Of Confrontation

- Immodest attire, filthy language, fornication, adulterous remarriages, homosexuality... (cf. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
- Must preach the whole counsel of God. (Acts 20:27; 1 Corinthians 5:6)
- "Your eyes are too pure to approve evil, And You can not look on wickedness with favor. Why do You look with favor On those who deal treacherously? <u>Why are</u> <u>You silent</u> when the wicked swallow up Those more righteous than they?" (Habakkuk 1:13 NAS)

NOTE: Jeremiah 6:10-12

The Loss Of Confrontation

God Despises Sin

- Proverbs 15:9, "The way of the wicked is an abomination to Jehovah"
- Proverbs 28:9, "He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, Even his prayer is an abomination."

The Loss Of Confrontation

The Gospel Is Confrontational

- Evangelism is not possible without confrontation. (cf. Acts 2:36; 3:12-15; 4:8-10)
- Demands accountability for sin. (Romans 14:12; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Acts 17:30-31)
- Jesus came to call sinners to repentance (Luke 5:32); to "seek and save the lost." (Luke 19:10)
- Lord called for repentance from five of the seven churches of Asia. (Revelation 2:5, 16, 21; 3:3, 19)
- Paul called on churches to put to death the deeds of the body. (Colossians 3:5-11)
