Discouragement

- "To deprive of courage or confidence: dishearten" (Webster)
- Deep and sober concern due to real problems can lead to discouragement.
 - Hard pressed and perplexed. 2 Corinthians 4:8-10
 - Jesus faced it and overcame it. Hebrews 4:15; 5:7-9 (1 Peter 2:21)

Discouragement takes many forms and has many causes

- **■Family matters.** John 7:2-5
 - Troubled marriage, children, illness, financial concerns, business, etc.
 - Misunderstandings and conflicts
 - Let none of these distract you from the focus of your faith. Matthew 6:25, 34

Discouragement takes many forms and has many causes

- **■Moral failures.** Luke 22:47-48, 61
 - Alcohol, drugs, sexual sins, lying, laziness, neglect, etc. (1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
 - Put away the past (with repentance) and press forward. Philippians 3:13-14

Discouragement takes many forms and has many causes

- Spiritual matters. Matthew 8:23-26; Mark 4:35ff; Luke 8:22ff
 - ■Personal struggles of faith.
 - ■Little or no spiritual growth.
 - ■Sinful influences.
 - ■Church problems. (1 Corinthians 1:11)
 - Faithless brethren. (Deuteronomy 1:28)

Discouragement takes many forms and has many causes

- Remember the disappointments of others. Galatians 6:2
 - Job (Job 2:11-13); David (Psalms 22:1-2); Elijah (1 Kings 19:4); Jeremiah (Jeremiah 9: 1-2)
 - Discouragements come! Matthew 18:7
 - Helps avoid self-pity. (not alone!)
 - Opens you up to helping others. (great way to overcome discouragement! 2 Corinthians 1)

Jesus Overcame Discouragement

- **■With endurance**. Hebrews 12:1-2
 - He ruled His circumstances. Philippians 4:10-13
 - ■Your reasons to endure include:
 - More than conquerors. Romans 8:35-39
 - Christ in you is greater. 1 John 4:4
 - He never fails you. Hebrews 11:32-39

Jesus Overcame Discouragement

■With an eternal perspective.

- ■Look beyond the moment. John 4:25, 35
- ■See the light (not the darkness):
 - Made stronger and closer. James 1:2-4
 - Purify and rejoice. 1 Peter 1:6-9
 - Be an instrument for God's glory.2 Corinthians 4:14-15 (Note context)

Jesus Overcame Discouragement

■Jesus kept working.

- ■Stay active in your faith. John 9:4
- Look for the open path. Acts 16:6-10
 - Esther. Esther 4:14
 - Keep getting up. Proverbs 24:10, 16
 - Do not grow weary. Galatians 6:9-10

Jesus Overcame Discouragement

■Jesus prayed often.

- ■In nothing be anxious. Philippians 4:6-7
- ■Jesus' retreat. Luke 5:15-16; 6:12-13
- ■David's refuge. Psalms 55:1-8, 16-19
- ■Cast your burden on the Lord. Psalms 55:22-23; 1 Peter 5:6-7

■Jesus was thankful.

- Joy comes in the morning. (Psalms 30:4-5) John 11:41; 16:22
- God's presence and blessings sustain us through darkness and danger. Psalms 23:4
- Give thanks in everything. 1 Thessalonians 5:18

- ■God strengthens and saves.
 Psalms 31:21-24
 (Hebrews 13:5-6)
- ■"The Lord bless thee, and keep thee ... and give thee peace" Numbers 6:24-27
