




Dissatisfaction

Verses 12-13a "not that I have already attained ... (or made perfect)"

- We are soldiers. 2 Timothy 2:3
- We are farmers. 2 Timothy 2:6
- Job not done. cf. Revelation 3:1,17; 1 Corinthians 10:12
- Paul not finished. Verses 12-13a



Direction

Verse 13b "Stretching forward to the things that are before (ahead NASV)"

- Can't be controlled by the past.
cf. 1 Timothy 1:12-16
- Winners do not look back ... Victories or defeats.
- Reaching forward ... cf. Hebrews 12:1-2
- Paul placed his sinful past in the hands of his forgiving God ... cf. Hebrews 10:17;
cf. Acts 21:8; 22:20



Discipline

Verses 15-16 "Let us walk by the same rule."

- Discipline is necessary.
1 Corinthians 9:25-27
- We must learn to:
 - Gird up the loins of our minds.
1 Peter 1:13
 - Study to show ourselves approved.
2 Timothy 2:15

Discipline

- We must learn to:
 - Crucify the flesh with its passions and desires. Galatians 5:24
 - Fight the good fight of faith. 1 Timothy 6:12
 - Pray without ceasing. 1 Thessalonians 5:17
 - Follow the rules. 2 Timothy 2:5
If we plan on wearing an imperishable crown at the end of the race.

Conclusion:

- The "*crown of righteousness*" awaits those of us who follow the faithful example of Paul. (2 Timothy 4:6-8)
