

REMEMBER

We are prone to forget.

- Israel of old was constantly reminded, "Only take heed to thyself, and keep thy soul diligently, <u>lest thou forget</u> the things which thine eyes saw, and lest they depart from thy heart all the days of thy life; but make them known unto thy children and thy children's children …" (Deuteronomy 4:9)
- Moses warned that when they came into the promised land and began to partake of its blessings, "... then <u>beware lest</u> <u>thou forget</u> Jehovah, who brought thee forth out of the land of <u>Egypt</u>, out of the house of bondage" (Deuteronomy 6:10-12).

REMEMBER

We are prone to forget.

- And again, "Beware lest thou forget Jehovah thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his ordinances, and his statutes, which I command thee this day: lest, when thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt therein; and when thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied; then thy heart be lifted up, and thou forget Jehovah thy God, who brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage" (Deuteronomy, 8:11-14).
- Oh, how soon and how often they had forgotten God. "Can a virgin forget her ornaments, or a bride her attire? <u>yet my people have forgotten me days without number</u>" (Jeremiah 2:32)
