The Basis Of His Concern For The Lost (Acts 20)

- He regarded himself as a servant of the Lord. Verse 19
 - Past work in Ephesus as a servant. Ephesians 3:7-9
 - Paul frequently referred to himself as a "bondservant." Philippians 1:1; Romans 1:1; cf. 1 Corinthians 9:19

The Basis Of His Concern For The Lost (Acts 20)

• He regarded himself as a servant.

- Essential to saving the lost.
 - Jesus set the example.
 Matthew 20:28; Philippians 2:5-7
 - Christians called to serve.
 Matthew 20:26; Matthew 18:1ff;
 Romans 12:3; Hebrews 10:24

Characteristics Of Paul's Service Acts 20:19

- Paul's service was ...
- <u>Humble</u>. "With all lowliness of mind." Ephesians 4:1; Philippians 3:5-8; Galatians 6:14
- <u>Tearful</u>. "And with tears." Acts 20:31; 2 Corinthians 2:4
 - At Ephesus, tears caused by:
 - Ignorance. Acts 19:2
 - Blasphemy. Acts 19:9
 - Idolatry. Acts 19:28

Characteristics Of Paul's Service Acts 20:19

- Paul's service was ...
- <u>Humble</u>. "With all lowliness of mind." <u>Tearful</u>. "And with tears."

- Paul. Romans 9:1ff; 10:1

- Trying. "And with trials."

- cf. Acts 14:11-19; 2 Timothy 1:8; 4:5
- Labored with his hands. Acts 20:34;
 2 Corinthians 12:15
- Anxiety. 2 Corinthians 11:28
- <u>Rewarding</u>. Acts 19:9-10;
 1 Thessalonians 2:19ff; Philippians 1:21;
 4:1; 3 John 4

The Extent Of Paul's Concern For The Lost

- He went to the lost. (Went to Ephesus twice.) cf. John 4:35;
 Matthew 9:37ff; Philippians 4:16
- Taught fearlessly. "I shrank not from declaring to you ..." Verse 26; Ezekiel 3:18ff
- Taught "Publicly and from house to house." Verse 20; cf. 1 Corinthians 9:16; 2 Timothy 4:2

The Extent Of Paul's Concern For The Lost

- Taught all. "... Both Jews and Greeks." Verse 21; Acts 26:17; Galatians 2:7; cf. Romans 1,2,3; cf. James 2:1ff
- Taught persistently. Verses 18, 31; Romans 10:1; 9:3; John 9:4; Colossians 4:5
