

Redemption

1 Corinthians 1:30-31 – Redemption is summed up "*in Christ."*

Romans 3:19-26 – Christ the only means of redemption. cf. Ephesians 1:7

WHAT Is Redemption?

 English word "redemption" means to re-buy, "to regain possession of by repurchase." (Webster's Collegiate Dictionary, page 833)

WHAT Is Redemption?

Two Greek words translated as "Redeem / Redemption."

exagorazo, a strengthened form of agorazo, "to buy," denotes "to buy out" (ex for ek), especially of purchasing a slave with a view to his freedom.

This word "does not signify the actual redemption, but the PRICE PAID with a view to it."

(from Vine's Expository Dictionary, Vol. III, page 263)

Two Greek words translated as "Redeem / Redemption."

lutroo, "to release on receipt of ransom ... the ACTUAL DELIVERANCE, THE SETTING AT LIBERTY."

Man NEEDS Redemption

- Broken God's Law. Romans 3:20-24
- Man chooses to become the servant of sin.
 Romans 6:16-18
- To belong to the Lord again, one has to be redeemed.
 - Bought with a price.
 - Actual deliverance or release from sin.

WHO Redeems us?

God the Father.

- Psalms 111:9, "He hath sent redemption unto his people; He hath commanded his covenant for ever: Holy and reverend is his name."
- Psalms 19:14, "Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in thy sight, O Jehovah, my rock, and my redeemer."
- NOTE: 1 Corinthians 1:17ff chapter 2

WHO Redeems us?

Christ the Son.

Revelation 5:9; 1 Peter 1:18-19; Titus 2:14 Price Paid. Philippians 2:5-7; Hebrews 2:9; 1 Corinthians 6:20

WHO Redeems us?

Man's inability.

- Titus 3:5; Ephesians 2:8-9
- God in His grace, gave His Son and made possible my peace with God. Hebrews 9:12; cf. Romans 3:23-26.
- It is Christ who "delivers us from darkness and translates us into the kingdom of his dear son." (Colossians 1:13).
- He is a "ransom" Matthew 20:28;
 1 Timothy 2:6

FOR <u>WHOM</u> Was Redemption Provided?

Did Jesus provide atonement for only a few?

John 3:16, "God so loved the WORLD ...

WHOSOEVER ..."

Hebrews 2:9, "that by the grace of God he should taste of death for **EVERY** (man)."

FOR <u>WHOM</u> Was Redemption Provided?

Did Jesus provide atonement for only a few?

Revelation 22:17, "And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And **WHOSOEVER WILL**, let him take the water of life freely." KJV

Acts 10:34-35, "And Peter opened his mouth and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: but in **EVERY NATION** he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is acceptable to him."

Note: While both are translated "to redeem,"

<u>exagorazo</u> does not signify the actual "redemption," but the **PRICE PAID** with a view to it,

<u>lutroo</u>, "to release on receipt of ransom," signifies the **ACTUAL "DELIVERANCE**," the setting at liberty. (Vine)

WHERE Is Redemption?

Romans 3:24, "being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is IN CHRIST JESUS"

Ephesians 1:7, "<u>IN WHOM</u> we have our redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace"

Colossians 1:13-14, "who delivered us out of the power of darkness, and translated us into the kingdom of the Son of his love; <u>IN WHOM</u> we have our redemption, the forgiveness of our sins"

 lutroo the actual "deliverance," the setting at liberty, is obtained "IN CHRIST."

NOTE: As long as one is out of Christ, he is not redeemed.

Review: WHAT Is Redemption?

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WHEN Are We Redeemed?

Redemption is "IN CHRIST." Romans 3:24

One is redeemed WHEN he gets into Christ.

We Enter Into Christ WHEN We Are Baptized INTO Christ

Galatians 3:26-27, "For ye are all sons of God, through faith, in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were <u>baptized into Christ did put on Christ."</u>
Romans 6:3-4, "Or are ye ignorant that all we who were <u>baptized into Christ Jesus</u> were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him through baptism unto death: that like as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness

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Redemption
