- Not be stubborn / self willed.
 - Matthew 7:12; Titus 1:7; 3 John
 - Not refuse to yield, listen, or work things out
- Gentle, easy to be entreated. (2 Timothy 2:24; James 3:17)

- Part of love (1 Corinthians 13:4)
- Proverbs 18:24, "He that maketh many friends (doeth it) to his own destruction; But there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother."
