

Heart Must Be Changed!

•Matthew 15:18-20, "But the things which proceed out of the mouth come forth <u>out of</u> <u>the heart</u>; and they defile the man. For <u>out</u> <u>of the heart</u> come forth evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, railings: these are the things which defile the man; but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not the man."

•Acts 15:9, "and he made no distinction between us and them, <u>cleansing their hearts</u> by faith."



Conscience

Corruption begins in the heart. (Matthew 15:18f)

Salvation must therefore begin in the heart. (Romans 10:10)

- •The apostles to <u>wait</u> for the coming of the Holy Spirit – Luke 24:46-49
- •Holy Spirit's coming <u>near</u> Acts 1:8
- •Holy Spirit <u>came</u> Acts 2:1-4
- •Holy Spirit's <u>convicts</u> John 16:8

An Inspired Example

– Jews – Acts 2

Pricked ... convicted of sin.

≻HOW? "When they heard this."

- <u>Heard what</u>? The Spirit inspired words of Peter.
 But Jesus said that the Holy Spirit would
 "convict the world of sin." John 16:8
- ➤<u>Conclusion</u> ... The Holy Spirit convicted the sinners on that day of Pentecost through the instrumentality of the word of God.

- •COMMANDS issued. Verses 36, 38
- •PROMISES offered. Verses 38-39

Conscience Cleansed - cf. 1 Peter 3:21

<u>Hearts changed</u>: "They then that received his word were baptized: and there were added (unto them) in that day about three thousand souls." Verse 41

CONCLUSION:

- Truly, every conversion is begun and consummated by the Spirit.
- As the "revealing agent" in man's conversion, He reveals the wonderful love and goodness of God. John 3:16; Romans 2:4
- He reveals the awful plight of man lost in sin. Romans 3:23
