The Declarations of God's Love

- o **John 3:16** Declares the **DEGREE** of God's love.
 - He "so" loved ... John 3:16 houtoos "in this manner, thus, so" (Thayer)
- He Gave His Son. Philippians 2:5-11; Matthew 27:27-56
- This is how a husband loves his wife.Ephesians 5:25
- o This is how a mother loves her child. Titus 2:4
- This is how a soldier loves his country. 2 Timothy 2:2-3

The Declarations of God's Love

- **Romans 5:8** declares the **OBJECTS** of God's love.
 - John 3:16 He loved the world.
 - Sinners. cf. Ephesians 2:1-2
 - ∘ Sin defined. 1 John 3:4; James 4:17
 - o What sin does. Isaiah 59:1-2
 - Sin carries the death penalty.Romans 6:23; Revelation 20:14
 - What Christ did. Isaiah 53;
 2 Corinthians. 5:21; 1 Peter 2:24;
 Hebrews 2:9-10

The Declarations of God's Love

- o **Romans 8:35-39** Declares the **CONSTANCY** of God's love.
 - Nothing can separate us from God's love.
 - But we can separate ourselves from a relationship with God. Isaiah 59:1-2; cf. Romans 10:21

The Declarations of God's Love

- 1 John 4:9-10 Declares the **DESIGN** of God's love.
 - That we might have life. cf. Galatians 3:21, 10-11 ocf. John 5:40; 10:10; 20:31
 - He became a ransom. Matthew 20:28
 - He became our propitiation.1 John 2:2

The Declarations of God's Love

- **1 John 4:9-10** Declares the **DESIGN** of God's love.
- oGod's love provides:
 - Life for the spiritually dead. (cf. Luke 15)
 - Redemption for those enslaved to sin. Romans 3:23-26
 - Freedom from the bondage of sin. Romans 6:16ff; 8:1-2

The Declarations of God's Love

1 John 3:1-3 Declares the **REWARD** of God's love.

- We are changed:
 - oFrom sinners into sons. 1 John 3:1; Romans 8:14ff
 - oCitizens of the kingdom of darkness into citizens of the kingdom. Colossians 1:13-14
 - oPromised a changed body. 1 John 3:2; Philippians 3:20-21; 1 Corinthians 15

Motives Of Love

○ Admiration.

- This was NOT what motivated God's love for man. Genesis 6:5; cf. John 14:21
- This is a motive that causes us to love God.
 1 John 4:19

Motives Of Love

Gratitude.

- This was NOT what motivated God to love us. Romans 3:23
- Man's love for God should be motivated by what God has done for us. Romans 1:21; Colossians 3:15
- Psalms 118:19,21,28-29
- Psalms 136:1-3,26
- Psalms 138:1-2,4
- Psalms 139:14

Motives Of Love

o <u>Pity</u>.

- This was a motive for God to love us. Proverbs 14:12; Isaiah 55:8-9; Titus 3:5; Ephesians 2:1-10
- It is not a motive for our love for God!

Obligations Of Love

- God is NOT obligated to man.Ephesians 2:4
- What obligations must we assume if we love God?
 - We must live for Christ.
 Corinthians 5:14-15;
 Galatians 2:20; Matthew 6:33
 - 2. We must love one another. 1 John 4:11; 20-21
 - 3. We must obey His commandments. John 14:21-24

Conclusion:

The Love Of God.

- Should obligate those outside of Christ to obey the gospel.
- Should obligate those "in Christ" to be faithful in service and worship.
- God first loved us. 1 John 4:19
- Do you love HIM? John 14:15
