The Pulpit

Nehemiah 8:1-8

Preachers and Preaching

- Expectations and demands of preachers (some right and some wrong)
- <u>Men</u>: Isaiah 30:10; Jeremiah 5:31; Matthew 15:12;
 2 Timothy 4:3
- <u>God</u>: 2 Timothy 4:2; Acts 20:27; 1 Corinthians 2:1-2
- Goal of gospel preaching: Conviction and conversion of soul. John 16:8 (2 Timothy 4:2)
- <u>It is God's work</u> All must understand this and not cheapen it, disable it, or invalidate it by turning it into the work and wisdom of men.

The Pulpit is Not ...

• A <u>soapbox</u> to promote a personal agenda. Philippians 1:15-16

- Not for self-promotion. cf. 2 Corinthians 10:12, 17-18
- Hidden agendas obscure the glory of the cross. Galatians 6:12-15
- A <u>stage</u> to entertain the audience. 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 (Acts 8:9-11);
- 2 Timothy 4:3-4

The Pulpit is Not ...

• A <u>lectern</u> for academia (human wisdom).

- 1 Corinthians 1:26-29; 2:1, 4; Colossians 2:8, 18
- Preacher must boldly preach truth. Ephesians 6:19
 Not propose, suggest, offer options, and theorize.
- Bible produces faith, not doubt. 1 Timothy 1:4

When doubtful preaching is accepted, then gradually ...

- -The standard of absolute truth becomes relative.
- -Sin is minimized, becoming "differing yet honest opinions."
- –Worldliness invades thinking and churches.
- -Fellowship with sin and error broadens.
- -Distinctive message/meaning of the gospel is lost. 1 Peter 2:9-10

The Pulpit is Not ...

- A <u>rifle range</u> to take "pot shots" at one another. 3 John 9-10
- Document and address every issue, including identifying those in error. Matthew 16:6, 12; 2 Timothy 2:16-18; 4:10, 14-15; 3 John 9; Romans 16:17
- Do not preach personal attacks on a man.
- Preach against the error men teach, while preaching the "purity and simplicity that is in Christ"
 2 Corinthians 11:3
- Public and private teaching must work together. Acts 20:20 (Matthew 18:15); 2 Timothy 2:24-26

The Pulpit is ...

- A <u>divine charge</u>. 2 Timothy 4:1-2 (1 Corinthians 9:16)
- The entire word of God must be preached. Nehemiah 8:8; Acts 20:20, 25-27
- Make scriptural, practical applications that encourage, warn, and rebuke. 2 Timothy 4:2 (3:16-17)
- Be true to the message of truth. Acts 4:19-20

The Pulpit is ...

- A <u>sober responsibility.</u> (James 3:1) 2 Timothy 2:25-26; 4:5
- It must be motivated by love of God, love for truth, and love for souls. Philippians 1:15, 17
- Seize opportunities to serve and to save.
 1 Timothy 4:16; 2 Timothy 4:5

The Pulpit is ...

- A perpetual work. 2 Timothy 4:5
- <u>Repetition</u>: Continue preaching the same truth without fear, favor, or faltering. Philippians 3:1; (2 Peter 1:12-15)
- <u>Training and encouraging men to be</u> preachers. (Matthew 28:20); 2 Timothy 2:2
- <u>Sending and supporting sound gospel</u> preachers. Romans 10:14-15; Acts 13:2-3

The Pulpit is ...

- A blessing from Christ. Ephesians 4:11ff
- When misused, it becomes a curse. Galatians 1:6-9; (Titus 1:10-11)
- Preach to us "right things" (Isaiah 30:10)
