“The Son of Man”
Luke 19:10

1. **“Came”**
 - according to God’s purpose: 1 Peter 1:20; Ephesians 1:3-4; 3:11
 - in the “fulness of time”: Galatians 4:4; Mark 1:15
 - incarnate (deity in flesh): John 1:14; 2 Peter 1:16-19; Romans 1:4

Luke 19:10

2. **“To seek”**
 - not his own glory, but the Father’s : John 8:50; cf. 6:15; Matthew 4:8-10
 - by his example:
 - * of love: John 15:12-13
 - * of humility / obedience: Phil. 2:5-8
 - * of suffering: 1 Peter 2:21
 - * of power: Matthew 4:1-10

Luke 19:10

- who will hear & open to Him: Revelation 3:20
 - * many seek other things:
 - ✓ material things: 2 Timothy 3:2
 - ✓ signs: Mark 8:12
 - ✓ glory of man: John 5:44
 - ✓ worldly wisdom: 1 Corinthians 1:22
 - ✓ their own things: Philippians 2:21

Luke 19:10

3. **“To Save”**
 - Those lost in sin: Romans 3:23; 1 John 3:4; 5:17; cf. Mark 12:34; Acts 26:28
 - By His blood: Romans 3:25-26; John 10:17-18; Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 1:18-19
 - * thru word of the cross: 1 Cor. 1:18f
 - * at baptism: Romans 6:3-4
 - * by faithfulness: 1 John 1:7

- Eternally: 2 Thessalonians 1:6-9
