

• 1 Peter 1:22-25, "Seeing ye have purified your souls in your <u>obedience to the truth</u> unto unfeigned love of the brethren, love one another from the heart fervently: having been begotten again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, through the <u>word of God</u>, which liveth and abideth. For, All flesh is as grass, And all the glory thereof as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower falleth: But the <u>word of the Lord</u> abideth for ever. And this is the <u>word of good tidings</u> which was preached unto you."

Conversion To Christ ... Requires The Word Of God

• Not a single case of conversion in the New Testament where the word or God was not preached, believed, and obeyed.

Acts 2:14-41; 4:4; 5:14; 5:42; 6:1, 7; 8:12; 11:20-21

The gospel is God's power to save.

Romans 1:16-17, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For therein is revealed a righteousness of God from faith unto faith: as it is written, But the righteous shall live by faith."

- Corinthians. 1 Corinthians 15:1-2
- Colossians. Colossians 1:21-23
- Converts on first preaching tour. Acts 14:19ff
- Ephesians. Acts 19:8-10, 20; 20:32
- Thessalonians. Acts 17:1-4; 2 Thessalonians 2:15 NOTE: **2 John 9; Jude 3; 2 Peter 3:18**

Why Be Anchored In The Word?

<u>Consider its source</u>.

- Came from God. 1 Thessalonians 2:13
- Came through Christ. Luke 10:16; 1 Corinthians 14:37; Galatians 1:11-12
- Came by revelation of the Holy Spirit. Ephesians 3:1-5; John 14:26; 15:26-27; 16:13-14
- Revealed to the Apostles; ambassadors.
 2 Corinthians 5:20; John 17:8, 14, 18; 1 Thessalonians 4:8
 Words selected by the Holy Spirit. 1 Corinthians 2:12-13
 - Earthen vessels. 2 Corinthians 4:7
 - "my gospel" 2 Timothy 2:8
- "committed to my trust" 1 Timothy 1:11

Why Be Anchored In The Word?

Consider its sufficiency.

- "Profitable" 2 Timothy 3:16-17
 - "For doctrine" or "Teaching" ASV
 - "For reproof" Ephesians 5:11; 2 Timothy 4:2
 - "For correction" to set right again, correct.
- The scriptures are sufficient to make the "man of God ... complete, furnished completely unto every good work."
- 2 Peter 1:3, "Seeing that His divine power hath granted unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that called us ~by his own glory and virtue."

Why Be Anchored In The Word?

- Consider its authority.
 - •It is the standard by which all religious teaching and practice is to be tested. 1 Thessalonians 5:21; cf. 1 John 4:1
 - •Must examine the Scriptures. Acts 17:11; 2Timothy 2:15; 1 Peter 3:15

Why Be Anchored In The Word?

• <u>Consider its authority</u>. Standard of Judgment.

- John 12:48, "He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my sayings, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I spake, the same shall judge him in the last day."
- Romans 2:16, "... the day when God shall judge the secrets of men, according to my gospel, by Jesus Christ."
- Matthew 7:21, "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father who is in ¹⁰) heaven."

Why Be Anchored In The Word?

• <u>Consider its power</u>.

Psalms 119:11, "Thy word have I laid up in my heart, that I might not sin against thee."

The word of God "works" in those who believe ... 1 Thessalonians 2:13

- By the word the new birth is effected. 1 Peter 1:23
- By it the soul is saved. James 1:21
- By it we are sanctified. John 17:17; 1 Timothy 4:5
- It prevails mightily. Acts 19:20
- Like seed, Mark 4:26-27, it has power in itself to produce.
- It is living and active. Hebrews 4:12
- It is like fire against that which is false. Jeremiah 23:29
- It is like a hammer against that which is strong. Jeremiah 23:29
- It is light in darkness. Psalms 119:105
- \bullet It is the weapon in our warfare. Ephesians $6{:}17$
