2 Corinthians 13:5

"<u>Try your own selves</u>, whether ye are in the faith; prove your own selves. Or know ye not as to your own selves, that Jesus Christ is in you? unless indeed ye be reprobate."

We should regard self as the greatest enemy.

- Greater than Satan and this world, for these must have the cooperation of self to conquer anyone. James 4:7
- Matthew 16:24 "If any man would come after me, let him <u>deny himself</u>, and take up his cross, and follow me."
- Control ourselves ... 1 Corinthians 9:27; 2 Peter 1:6

<u>Self Examination Must Be Personal</u>. Ezekiel 18:20

• Judgment is personal. 2 Corinthians 5:10; Romans 14:12

• The question is not:

- "Am I physically strong?" 1 Timothy 4:8
- "Am I intellectually brilliant?" cf. 1 Corinthians 1:18ff
- "Am I popular among men?" Galatians 1:10
- But the question is, "Am I in the faith? Am I faithful to God?" cf. Matthew 25:31-32

Self Examination Must Be By The <u>Right Standard</u>.

- Cannot examine our selves by others. cf. 2 Corinthians 10:12
- One cannot examine himself by the standards and doctrines of men. Isaiah 55:8-9; 1 Corinthians 1:18ff
- Foolish to trust feelings. Proverbs 14:12; Luke 18:9; cf. Matthew 7:23ff
- The standard by which we examine ourselves should be the high and infallible word of God. John 12:48

<u>The Examination Must Be</u> <u>Thorough</u>.

• Whether you are in the faith is not to be assumed, but proven. Psalms 139:23-24; cf. Psalms 19:7-14

<u>The Examination Must Be</u> <u>Thorough</u>.

- We must grow. Hebrews 5:11-6:1; Ephesians 4:14
- We must strive to go on to perfection. Philippians 3:14

Self Examination Must Be Honest.

- Cannot be biased in favor of self. cf. Numbers 32:23
- Forgiveness obtained in obedience. 1 John 1:8-10
 - Proverbs 28:13-14 He that covereth his transgressions shall not prosper: But whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall obtain mercy. Happy is the man that feareth alway; But he that hardeneth his heart shall fall into mischief.

The Examination Must Be Continuous.

- Paul exercised discipline regularly. 1 Corinthians 9:27
- Must look into the perfect law and DO. James 1:25
- When we find sin, we must confess it. 1 John 1:7
- Crown of life promised to the faithful. Revelation 2:10
