2 Peter 2:1-14, "having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; enticing unstedfast souls; having a heart exercised in covetousness; children of cursing"

### **Unstable Souls**

Many are "unstable (unsteadfast ASV) souls" (2 Peter 2:14; 3:16)

#### Reuben.

• Genesis 49:3-4, "Reuben, thou art my first-born, my might, and the beginning of my strength; The pre-eminence of dignity, and the pre-eminence of power.

**Boiling over as water,** thou shalt not have the pre-eminence; Because thou wentest up to thy father's bed; Then defiledst thou it: he went up to my couch." ASV

- ▶ Genesis 49:4, "Uncontrolled as water, you shall not have preeminence, Because you went up to your father's bed; Then you defiled it – he went up to my couch." NASU
- Genesis 49:44, "Unstable as water, thou shalt not excel; because thou wentest up to thy father's bed; then defiledst thou it: he went up to my couch." KJV

## Characteristics of Unstable Souls

#### They are double-minded. James 1:6-8; 4:8

- Double-minded man: dispuchos literally refers to a "two-souled" person.
- "Wavering, uncertain, doubting; divided in interest" (Thayer).
- ▶ Examples:
  - ∘ Israel. 1 Kings 18:21
  - Multitude. Matthew 6:24
  - $^{\circ}$  Rich young ruler. Matthew 19:16ff
  - $^{\circ}$  Man who sought to eat at the table of the Lord and at the table of demons.1 Corinthians 10:21
  - The lukewarm person is a double-minded person. Revelation 3:15
- They are double-minded because they have two interests which are in conflict with each other; they are attempting to do the impossible - to serve both of them at the same time.

## Characteristics of Unstable Souls

#### They are double-minded. James 1:6-8; 4:8

- Stable man has a fixed persuasion that God is, and that He is the Hearer of prayer.
- ▶ Stable man must expect an answer to his supplications, and be ready to mark the time and mode of it.
- ▶ cf. Paul. Acts 27:25; 2 Timothy 1:12

### Characteristics of Unstable Souls

# They are tossed to and fro by every wind of doctrine. Ephesians 4:14-15

- ▶ Congregations.
  - $^{\circ}$  Pergamum. Revelation 2:12ff
  - Thyatira. Revelation 2:18ff
- ▶ Preachers.
  - Demas. 2 Timothy 4:10

### Characteristics of Unstable Souls

#### Do not count the cost, do not persevere. Luke 14:25; cf. Luke 8:14

An unstable character is marked by these traits:

- (a) He acts out of passion.
- (b) He is strongly influenced by what others think about him.
- (c) He is constantly fluctuating.
- (d) He has a divided allegiance.

# Maturity Is Marked By Stability

# A mature Christian is rooted and grounded in his commitment to Christ.

- ► He is rooted and grounded in love. Ephesians 3:17
- ▶ His love for God is first. Matthew 22:37
- ▶ The stable Christian does not have to decide with every confrontation whether or not he is going to serve Christ.
- ▶ He has made his commitment to Christ and will be faithful to it. "As for me and my house ..." Joshua 24:15

## Maturity Is Marked By Stability

# A mature Christian is rooted and grounded in the faith.

- ▶ Learned the revelation of God; he can discern between good and evil. Hebrews 5:11-14; cf. Colossians 1:23; 2:6-7; 2 Thessalonians 2:7
- ▶ His knowledge of God's word enables him to recognize false doctrine. 2 John 9–11
- ▶ He stands opposed to those who bring it. Romans 16:17-18
- ▶ When false teachers come, the mature Christian can be counted on to stand for the truth for he is rooted and grounded in the faith.

# Maturity Is Marked By Stability

# The mature Christian perseveres through the temptations and trials of life.

Like Job and the prophets endured affliction with faith in God. James 5:7-11

### Conclusion:

#### A stable person is one on whom you can rely.

- ▶ He will be faithful in attendance.
- ▶ He is stable in doctrine.
