The Invitation

What, then, is the invitation?

- O Lead souls to respond to God's saving grace.
- O Build faith in Christ and in His word.
- Convict men of sin and tell them of its remedy and retribution.
- O Strongly urge them to obey the direct demands of obedience faith, repentance, confession, and baptism. Acts 8:12, 35-36; 16:32-33
- O Tell them what awaits them if they do not obey the 4 truth. 2 Thessalonians 1:8; Romans 2:6-9; 1 Peter 4:17-18

The Invitation

What, then, is the invitation?

- O Preach the truth.
- O Press it into the hearts of men and lovingly insist that they obey it.
- O Decision!
- O God will give the increase (1 Corinthians 3:7), and you will be pure from the blood of all men (Acts 20:26). $_5$
