## The Gospel and the Heart

- Designed to penetrate hearts and change lives. Acts 2:36-37; James 1:21-23; Acts 15:8-9
- We decide what kind of heart we have. Matthew 13:14-15; 22:37
  - God calls on us to choose to have a new heart. Ezekiel 18:30-32

# The Parable of the Sower Matthew 13:3-9

- Gives discernment and understanding to those ready to hear truth. 13:10-12, 16-17; Mark 4:13
- The dull, hard heart will not listen, learn, and live, Matthew 13:14-15
- "Therefore, hear the parable of the sower," 13:18
  - Attend to, consider, perceive what is said.

What kind of heart do you have?

WAYSIDE: HARD, CLOSED HEART Matthew 13:19

- Chooses not to understand the word.
- We choose to understand the truth. (John 7:17)
- When the devil is not resisted, belief is rejected and salvation is prevented. Luke 8:12
- <u>Refutes</u> "Calvinism" the direct operation of the Holy Spirit for salvation!
  - Heart receives God's word or is hardened to it <u>by</u> <u>choice</u>. Hebrews 3:7-8 (10)
  - cf. Pharoah's heart.

<u>WAYSIDE</u>: HARD, CLOSED HEART Matthew 13:19

#### What leads one to a hard, closed heart?

- Sin. Hebrews 3:12-14 (Deceitful, alluring, captivating)
- Ingratitude and pride. Romans 1:21-22
- Gospel is viewed as foolishness.1 Corinthians 1:23

<u>WAYSIDE</u>: HARD, CLOSED HEART Matthew 13:19

- Does this describe your heart toward God's word?
  - When you hear its message about Jesus/Christ?
  - When you hear its message about *sin and salvation*?
  - When you hear its *plan of salvation*?
- Do not let the devil snatch the word from your heart! Matthew 13:19

### STONY: SHALLOW, EMOTIONAL HEART Matthew 13:20-21

- Failure to count the cost of discipleship is a heart problem. Luke 9:57-62
  - Joyful beginning. Acts 8:39; 16:34
  - But, no root (13:21). Luke 14:25-33
  - Tests of faith come. 13:21; Proverbs 24:10, 16
  - REFUTES "CALVINISM" ONCE SAVED, ALWAYS SAVED. Luke 8:13
- Immediately stumbles. 13:21 (cf. 24:9-13)
  - Without deep faith we will separate ourselves from the love of Christ! Romans 8:37-39

THORNY: OVER-CROWDED HEART Matthew 13:22

• Does not make room for God's word.

Mark 4:19 (Luke 8:14)

- Double-minded, unstable, impure. James 1:8; 4:8
- Cares of the world. Matthew 6:24
- Deceitfulness of riches. Luke 12:15
- Desire of other things (pleasures). Proverbs 23:23
- Forgets its cleansing from sin. 2 Peter 1:8-9
  - REFUTES "CALVINISM" UNCONDITIONAL ELECTION (1 Timothy 2:4)

### GOOD: HONEST AND GOOD HEART Matthew 13:23

- Hears, understands, and receives the word. Mark 4:20
  - Renewed by the word of God. John 15:4-5, 7; Ephesians 4:20-24 (23); James 1:21
  - Says: "What must I do to be saved?" Acts 16:30
    - REFUTES "CALVINISM" TOTAL, HEREDITARY DEPRAVITY
- Bears fruit by patient obedience. Luke 8:15
  - Endure by continuing to do good works. Matthew 10:22; Romans 2:7; Galatians 6:9
