- ❑ Trust God when things look bad. Daniel 3:16-18; Hebrews 10:32-39; John 8:24; Matthew 11:28-30; Mark 16:16
- ❑ Have a firm anchor in storms of life. Hebrews 6:13-20; 2:1; 1 Corinthians 15:58

Being A Survivor

- ❑ Abide in the Lord. John 8:31-32; John 15:1-7; Romans 6:1-4; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 4:17ff
- ❑ Partake of God's provisions.
 - Study. 2 Timothy 2:15; Hebrews 5:11-14; Psalms 119:11
 - Pray. Philippians 4:4-7; Matthew 6:9-15; 1 Thessalonians 5:17
 - Worship. Psalms 96:7-9
 - Serve. Matthew 20:20-28; Romans 12:1-2; James 1:27
