

## Blood In The Scheme Of Redemption

Hebrews 9:22

### Blood in the OT

- Not to be eaten. Genesis 9:4
- The blood of the covenant.
  - Covenant of circumcision. Genesis 17:1-14
  - Covenant of the Law. Exodus 24:1-8; cf. Hebrews 9:18-22

### Blood in the OT

- Blood for atonement. Leviticus 16
  - “Kapar” “figuratively, to expiate or condone, to placate or cancel:
    - KJV - appease, make (an atonement, cleanse, disannul, forgive, be merciful, pacify, pardon, purge (away), put off, (make) reconcile (-liation).” (Strong’s)

### Blood in the OT

- Blood for atonement (*kāpar*) Leviticus 16
  - Two goats, one was sent away into the wilderness as an atonement (verse 10), **while the other was sacrificed and its blood sprinkled on the mercy seat as an atonement for the people** (verses 15-20).
  - cf. Hebrews 9:7

### Blood in the NT

- Not to be eaten. Acts 15:22-29
- Blood of Jesus, blood of covenant. Matthew 26:28

### Blood in the NT

- Obtains eternal life. Hebrews 9:11
- Cleanses. Hebrews 9:14
- New Covenant dedicated with the blood of Christ. Hebrews 9:18-26
- Blood of New Covenant for remission of sins. Matthew 26:28

- Things the blood of Christ does.
1. Redeems. Ephesians 1:7; 1 Peter 1:18-19
  2. Provides Propitiation. Romans 3:25
  3. Justifies. Romans 5:9
  4. Sanctifies. Hebrews 13:12
  5. Cleanses. 1 John 1:7
  6. Looses or washes. Revelation 1:5
  7. Makes nigh. Ephesians 2:13
  8. Provides peace. Colossians 1:20
  9. Purchased the church. Acts 20:28; Ephesians 5:25-27
