Psalms 148 The Joy-Song of Creation

- The last five Psalms begin and end with, "*Praise* ye *Jehovah*." (ASV)
- Psalms 148 is the third Hallelujah Psalm.

Psalms 148 The Joy-Song of Creation

Psalms 148:1-6 – Praise Him – Creatures above the earth 1 "Praise ye Jehovah. Praise ye Jehovah from the heavens:

- praise him in the heights.
- 2 "Praise ye him, all his angels: praise ye him, all his host.3 "Praise ye him, sun and moon: praise him, all ye stars of light.
- 4 "Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that are above the heavens.
- 5 "Let them praise the name of Jehovah; for <u>he</u> <u>commanded</u>, <u>and they were created</u>.
- 6 "He hath also established them for ever and ever: He hath made a decree which shall not pass away."

Psalms 148 The Joy-Song of Creation

Psalms 148:7-12 – Praise Him – Creatures of the earth. All men.

- 7 "Praise Jehovah from the earth, ye sea-monsters, and all deeps.
- 8 "Fire and hail, snow and vapor; Stormy wind, fulfilling his word;
- 9 "Mountains and all hills; fruitful trees and all cedars;
- 10 "Beasts and all cattle; creeping things and flying birds;
- 11 "Kings of the earth and all peoples; princes and all judges of the earth;
- 12 "Both young men and virgins; old men and children:"

Psalms 148 The Joy-Song of Creation

Psalms 148:13-14 - Praise Him - Motive.

- 13 "Let them praise the name of Jehovah; for his name alone is exalted; His glory is above the earth and the heavens."
- Psalms 8:1, "O Jehovah, our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth, who hast set thy glory upon the heavens!"
- 14 "And he hath lifted up the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye Jehovah."
- He had raised up ... a horn (a strong one, i.e., a king; cf. 89:17; 132:17) for His beloved people.
