"Fess" – to admit to something

Confession

"An avowal of belief in a particular faith..." (The American Heritage College Dictionary)

- Rom 10:8-15
 - Mt. 16:15-17; Mt. 3:17; Mt. 17:5; 2 Peter 1:16-17

Confession

- He is the Christ
 - Anointed, the Messiah (usually a consecrated person (king, priest...))
 - Heb. 12:2; 1:1-5, 8-9
 - Phil. 2:5-11 (Lk. 4:8)

Confession

- We confess our belief that Jesus died.
 - 1 Cor. 11:23-26; Heb. 9:15-18, 13-14, 10:26-31
- We confess that He was raised from the dead.
 - 1 Cor. 15:1-4, Jn. 20:30-31; 1 Cor. 15:11-20

Profession

An occupation or career...an occupation such as law that requires considerable training and specialized study. An act or instance of professing, a declaration. An avowal of faith or belief. (Ibid. (shortened))
