## Jesus: Intolerant, Confrontational, and Exclusionary?

Matthew 10:26-33

#### Introduction

#### Many proclaim, "God is love"

- I John 4:8, 16 "God is love"
- But many want to say that "God is ONLY love"

#### They overlook/discard:

- Deuteronomy 4:24 "God is a consuming
- Romans 1:18-19 "... the wrath of God is revealed ..."
- Romans 11:22 "... the kindness and the severity of God"

#### Introduction

#### Jesus is commonly depicted as quiet, soft-spoken, harmless

- There is no fear of Him
- II Corinthians 5:10-11 "knowing the fear of the Lord"

#### They believe He will accept any form of worship man will devise

- A "cleaned up" Jesus who preaches a "cleaned up" gospel
  • Matthew 7:22-23 – "depart from me, you
- workers of lawlessness"

### God Wants All People To Be Saved

- I Timothy 2:3-4 "... desires all people to be saved ...'
- Titus 2:11 "bringing salvation for all people"
- Matthew 25:46 "... into eternal life"

#### God Is no respecter of persons

- Genesis 12:1-3 "... all the families of the earth shall be blessed
- Matthew 28:19-20 "... make disciples of all nations"
- Acts 10:34-35 "... God shows no partiality"

### The Side of Jesus Often Ignored

#### Jesus was intolerant of sin and those who promoted it

- Matthew 11:21-22 "Woe to you"
- Matthew 15:3-9 "their heart is far from me"
- Matthew 16:6,12 "beware of the leaven"
- Matthew 22:29 "... you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of God"
- Matthew Chapter 23 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!" (5 times)
- Matthew 24:24 "... to lead astray, if possible, even the elect"

### The Side of Jesus Often Ignored

#### Jesus' disciples followed His example of intolerance

- Acts 5:1-11 "... you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord"
- Acts 15:1-2 "... dissension and debate with them"
- Galatians 2:4-5 "... we did not yield in submission even for a moment"
- Ephesians 5:6-11 "Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness"
- II Timothy 2:15-18 "... upsetting the faith ..."

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# The Side of Jesus Often Ignored

## The language of the early preachers is similar to that of Jesus in Matthew 23

- Acts 7:51-52 "You stiff-necked people"
- Acts 13:8-10 "You son of the devil"
- Acts 20:29-30 "to draw away the disciples"
- James 4:1-10 "You adulterous people!"

Truth should never be given equal weight with error

## The Side of Jesus Often Ignored

## Jesus was confrontational toward those who knew the truth but rejected it

- Mark 3:1-6 "Is it lawful ..."
- Luke 13:10-17 "... were put to shame"
- Luke 14:1-6 "Is it lawful ..."

#### Jesus confronted people with the fact that He was deity

- John 5:16-18 "... calling God his own Father"
- John 8:58-59 "I am"
  - cf. Exodus 3:13-15 "This is my name forever"

# The Side of Jesus Often Ignored

## Preachers in the early church were just as confrontational

- Acts 4:19-20 "... to listen to you rather than to God"
- Acts 5:29 "We must obey God rather than men"
- Chapter 7 "you always resist the Holy Spirit"
- Galatians 2:11-13 "I opposed him to his face"

# The Side of Jesus Often Ignored

#### Jesus excluded many by His teaching

• John 6:60-66 – "This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?"

#### Jesus insisted on obedience

- John 14:21 "Whoever has my commandments and keeps them"
- I John 2:3-6 "whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked"

#### What God Wants You To Do

#### Hear the Word of God

 James 1:21 – "... receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls."

#### Believe the Gospel message about Jesus

• I John 3:23-24 – "that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ"

#### Repent of your sins

 Acts 3:19 – "Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out"

#### What God Wants You To Do

#### Confess that Jesus is the Son of God

• Romans 10:9-10 – "... with the mouth one confesses and is saved"

#### Be immersed in water

 Acts 2:38 – "Repent and be baptized every one of you ..."

#### Remain faithful

 Hebrews 3:12-14 – "... if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end"

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
